Introduction:

It is an honour to announce the arrival of most needed entity in the college campus, 'The compost pit'. Nowadays due to enhancement of technology, machine and usages of various human ease materials, the generation of solid waste in the entire country has seen a rapid growth in the past decade, dependence on various use and throw materials has degraded the environmental appearance of the surrounding and peace due to its improper management at initial levels.

To tackle the situation various governmental and nongovernmental organisations are working 24 x 7 for finding the best suitable solution. "Stree Mukti Sanghatana" an NGO by Ms. Jyoti Mhapsekar has been doing the hardships from last couple of decades to find the right way in setting up a role model for people.

An initiative has been taken by Prof Uma kale, Asst.Prof.Civil Engg.Dept., Prof Zaheer Khan, Head of Civil Engineering Dept. and team strongly supported by Anjuman-I-Islam to set up a compost pit in the college campus to ensure proper handling of solid waste in the college premises itself, towards making the premises a "Zero Waste Campus".

Solid waste contains various ingredients which are of no use to the owner. However, these ingredients can be used as a raw material to produce some useful forms of material or as a source of energy. It is important to know for us that solid waste is a heterogeneous material and its composition varies from place to place, the process involved in the solid waste management of one area may be same for every place but the end results could be unique.

A study of overall composition of solid waste in the campus of M.H.SABOO SIDDIK COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING was done through waste auditing an analysis of the various components in its varying quantity was quantified by proper engineering tests and results were concluded. To help the Municipal corporation of greater Mumbai in handling of wastes generated and to meet the demands as concluded in the test performed a decision was taken to set up a compost pit in the premises which would enlighten the beauty of the campus and would help in making the campus clean and green.

Compost is a key ingredient in organic farming. At the simplest level, the process of composting requires making a heap of wet organic matter known as green waste (leaves, food waste) and waiting for the materials to break down into humus after a period of weeks or months. Modern, methodical composting is a multi-step, closely monitored process with measured inputs of water, air, and carbon- and

nitrogen-rich materials. The decomposition process is aided by shredding the plant matter, adding water and ensuring proper aeration by regularly turning the mixture. Worms and fungi further break up the material. Bacteria requiring oxygen to function (aerobic bacteria) and fungi manage the chemical process by converting the inputs into heat, carbon dioxide and ammonium. The ammonium (NH+)is the form of nitrogen used by plants. When available ammonium is not used by plants it is further converted by bacteria into nitrates (NO) through the process of nitrification. no modern technology which is an advantage in itself. The compost pits installed in the college.



There are two compost pits each of size 5'X4'X4' an additional height of 1' above the ground is provided to make it compatible and aerated, also the possibility of rodents damaging the structure is taken care of, each pit has a capacity of 3 tonnes and it has a lid of MS steel with MS net and both the pits are being covered by a shed of 0.5 mm thick steel with coating against corrosion.

The solid waste generation of college is not more than 150 kg at peak times, also 92 % components of the municipal solid waste in the college is biodegradable which can be put in the compost pit. The wet waste of the biodegradable part gets decomposed at a very fast rate and its volume reduces by more than 60 % as proven by various observations. The product of the whole process would be nutrient rich compost which can be used as manure for the recent plantation to be done under the zero waste campus projects.

As it does not require periodic maintenance the cost of operation as well as maintenance is negligible. Only initial cost of construction is the actual cost which has to be taken into consideration. As the whole process is aerated there is no question of stinking and odour, the compost pit has perforations

at regular intervals of 1' depth which will allow the passage of air to pass through the heap and makes it ventilated at all times, after a period of 25 to 30 days the first pouring of solid waste will be converted in to soil enriched with nutrients which can be taken out from the bottom opening provided.

Various problems which may be solved by installation of compost pit:

- 1. The cost to be paid to the BMC for Bulk Generation would be very nominal as very high before.
- 2. We would we making our own compost and manure for gardens .
- 3. The problem of segregation at source would be solved as we would be only using organic matter in compost pit.
- 4. It will add prestige to the college as we can achieve the goal towards Zero waste campus.
- 5. Educational Workshops regarding composting and segregation of waste can be practically arranged as we have the proper resources available for it and out motto of spreading awareness and educating them would be viable.


GUEST LECTURE:

A. Introduction to Hackathon "ERR_404 2.0 Hack Not Found"








How likely would you suggest this event to your friends?


EVENT SUMMARY
